

Summary of Annual Meeting

March 29, 2011

Every year in March, Rockfish Valley Community Center holds an annual membership meeting to report on The State of the Center and to elect members to the Board of Directors.

The 2011 Meeting was held on March 29. Approximately 30 RVCC members were in attendance for the Center's Eleventh Annual Meeting. A tasty spread of food was provided by Claudia Gibson prior to the meeting.

A slate of three new Directors and two current Directors were on the ballot for election to the Board of Directors. All five were elected by the members present for three year terms. Sue Chase, Roy White and Bob Yoder are new Directors; Gifford Childs and Margaret Clair were re-elected.

President Sarah Jane Stewart presented highlights from 2010 as described in the printed [Annual Report](#). Bob Kinney, Treasurer, gave the financial highlights of 2010 which included a \$13,000 net gain for the operation of RVCC, even though the Treasure Chest lost \$3700. Loss in the Hamner Theater was offset by carryover from the previous year, as was true for the Senior Group.

Members in attendance were encouraged to volunteer to help in various projects and fundraising events, as well as make donations.

The two newest tenants were introduced, David Lipscomb with his Virginia Rockhound shop; and Greg Ebelherr, health insurance agent. Outgoing Board members John Lauler and Dawn Bridge were thanked for their service. Eleanor Massie was recognized for her ten years of service working in the Treasure Chest. Sarah Jane Stewart was thanked for her service as President; she noted that a new president will be elected in April by the Board.
